

PROCEDURES FOR RECEIVING CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION

Sport Safety Program

We are very pleased to see your participation at one of our two 7-hour educational workshops and look forward to your involvement in a 1st aid assistance capacity with sport and recreation in your community or sport. Your newly learned skills will certainly assist you in prevention of injury and ensure knowledgeable actions and support if an injury occurs. Be sure you know your role! Always 'refer' to a medical professional!

CERTIFICATE

In order to receive a CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION for the Sport Safety Program, the Sport Medicine and Science Council of Saskatchewan (SMSCS) requires that individuals complete the following four courses/workshops:

- SMSCS Sport First Aid Workshop
- SMSCS Taping Workshop
- Standard First Aid Course
- Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation Course (CPR – Basic Life Support Level A minimum)

The first two components noted above are workshops offered by the Sport Medicine and Science Council. After completing either of these workshops, you will receive a wallet sized card indicating you have taken the Workshop. The other courses are offered by the Canadian Ski Patrol, Saskatchewan Heart Foundation, Red Cross, and St John Ambulance. A photocopy of these current certificates must accompany the form below in order to receive a CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION. **It should be noted this certificate does not give anyone any type of official certification. The SMSCS workshops are 'educational' workshops only, and are not certified by any professional body.**
